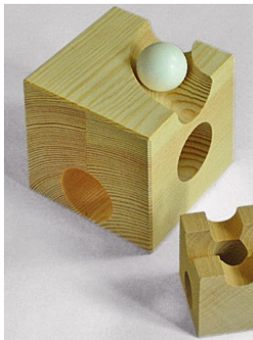

cuboro XXL – a marble track system hits it big

The wooden cubes of cuboro's marble track system have grown – the additional cubes have become a total of 8 times larger. The new «cuboro XXL» includes 30 cube elements with an edge lengths of 10 centimetres, equipped with funnels, channels, straights, turns and tunnels – thrilling elements, as usual, for the construction of a cuboro marble track system. According to Matthias Etter, manager of cuboro Ltd. and inventor, cuboro's XXL set is not produced primarily for commercial purposes, but mainly for the use at fairs, game festivals, on playgrounds and in other playing areas. Large wooden balls or balls of tabletop football serve as «marbles» for cuboro's large marble track system. The wooden elements impress: they smell of forest, the wooden structure is beautiful, clear and pure and the smoothly cut wood almost feels soft. Once held, one does not want to let go of such a cube.
