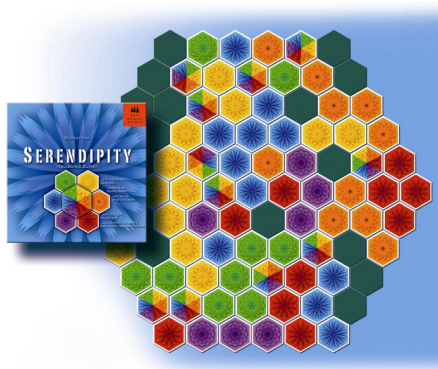

**Serendipity - strokes of luck and tactical dexterity**

With the flowery family game Serendipity the inventor of the cuboro marble track system, Matthias Etter, leaves his garden not for the first time and develops a new game which is about tactical dexterity and strokes of luck. Two to six players uncover 91 flower cards and try to make their own flower meadow as big and valuable as possible by swapping cards. The person who can remember where «his» flowers lie and can foresee moves for himself will score the points, unless another teammate thwarts his plans. The stroke of luck, the «Serendip-joker» enlarges not only the flower meadow but also the (points) account. The new gloriously colourful family game «Serendipity» (from 6 years of age) is published by Drei Magier Verlag/Schmidt Spiele, distributed in Switzerland by Carletto and in Germany by Schmidt Spiele.
